- Provides management and guidance for communications and sensor connectivity for command and control, battle management, and consequence management used by the First Air Force-Air Forces Northern/Continental United States North American Aerospace Defense Command Region Commander, Air Operations Center, Air Defense Sectors, Joint Air Defense Operations Center, and assigned wings in protection of the Continental United States.
- Develops and writes communications and information plans and procedures and resolves connectivity issues for the employment of sensor sites and associated communications.
- Performs as project oversight and life cycle manager for Have Quick II radio, Air Defense Communications Service and encryption, and Ground-Air-Ground Transmit/Receive radio programs.
- Coordinates with North American Aerospace Defense Command, United States Northern Command, Air Combat Command and Continental United States North American Aerospace Defense Command Region Air Defense Sectors in bedding down operational systems.
- Provides operational management of all Continental United States North American Aerospace Defense Command Region validated warfighter needs and develops directives, plans, policies and procedures for employment of over 175 sensor sites, and more than 140 ground-to-air communications sites of the National Airspace System Defense Program and Tethered Aerostat Radar System, as well as alert site scramble communications and tactical data links within the Continental United States North American Aerospace Defense Command Region Air Defense Sectors.

- Represents First Air Force Air Forces Northern at working groups and conferences with representatives from all command levels: Air Staff, United States Navy, United States Customs and Border Protection, Federal Aviation Administration and industry.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director's approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.
