





Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST)

ASIST is CREDO Southeast's premier suicide intervention and prevention workshop designed to train military members to identify people at risk for suicide, confidently intervene, provide suicide first aid, and save lives.

Training is interactive, utilizing small group discussions, skill-building practice sessions, and powerful videos on suicide intervention.

WHO: Military members, DoD, and military contract personnel are eligible. Participants should be motivated, mature, and interested in being a part of a command's suicide prevention network. E-4 and below will need recommendation from an E-7 or above.

WHEN: 27-28 October from 0730-1530 participation in BOTH days is required.
