What's in the News?

What can ESSENCE do for you? Syndromic surveillance using ESSENCE is useful in quickly assessing public health threats from large outbreaks and assisting with timely recognition of select reportable medical events. Regular monitoring allows you to learn what to expect in your population. Some "noise" is unavoidable but you will learn to look past this.

Got a command SOP that includes ESSENCE? A command SOP can help standardize your approach to ESSENCE and how it fits into your daily surveillance and reporting activities. The SOP can include monitoring routine, investigation of alerts and reportable events, matching ESSENCE reportable events with what is reported in DRSi, and communication pathways with your lab, providers, and chain of command. If you don't have as SOP, consider creating one!
