

**NMCPHC Health Interest Questionnaire**  
**Revised 1 January 2016**

The Health Interest Questionnaire (HIQ) available on the Navy and Marine Corps Public Health Center (NMCPHC) website is a tool that can assist Navy and Marine Corps commands in assessing the health interests of personnel at their command, which is an important and essential part of conducting their Command Health Promotion Assessment.

To utilize the HIQ, commands should appoint someone at the command as the HIQ Point of Contact (POC). This tool will generally be used when conducting the Command Health Promotion Assessment and so, in most cases, the HIQ POC will be the Command Health Promotion Coordinator or Officer, who will also be responsible for conducting the entire Command Health Promotion Assessment.
