SUBJECT: Guidance Letter No. 14, Revisions to Guidance for Disposal of Materials on Beaches

- 1. References:
- a. EC 1165-2-142, Cost Sharing for Disposal of Materials on Beaches -
- b. EC 1165-2-149, Cost Sharing for Shore Protection.
- c. PL 100-676, Water Resources Development Act of 1988.
- 2. The expiration date for EC 1165-2-142, when issued, was 31 December 1988. Beyond that date, the EC 1165-2-142 guidance (with the modifications noted below) should continue to be observed, until the contents are incorporated into the revised Planning Guidance Notebook.
- 3. Paragraph 5b(3) of EC 1165-2-142 states that storm damage reduction benefits must exceed 50 percent of the total benefits; however (see EC 1165-2-149, 15a), storm damage reduction benefits may be less than 50 percent if economic justification can be demonstrated on the basis of recreation benefits limited to 50 percent of total project benefits.
- 4. Section 35 of WRDA '88 requires consideration of a State's schedule for providing its share of funds for placing sand on beaches, and, to the maximum extent practicable, accommodation of such schedule.
