TOP STORY: New FRG Leader, Stacey Meyer, has joined the team. At her first meeting on May 7 she presented her short- and long-term priorities: (1) FRG participation in the AFRICOM Olympics, (2) ensure an <u>AFRICOM</u> Facebook page is developed and maintained, and (3) develop a standard approach for welcoming new family members to AFRICOM.

She will run everything by JAG and PAO. EUCOM has a great FB page and Stacey has a contact at EUCOM to learn about its FB best practices.
- 3. Welcome events for new families Sherrie Resch, Jessica Wilson and Ginny Rodriguez recently met to discuss a plan of action.
