MISSION ESSENTIAL PERSONNEL ONLY TOMORROW AT SOUTHSIDE NAVY INSTALLATIONS. NAVAL WEAPONS STATION YORKTOWN RESUMES NORMAL OPERATIONS

Norfolk, VA (CNRMA) – Due to continued effects from this week’s winter storm, Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic has directed that Mission Essential Personnel only report to work Friday, January 31 at Southside Hampton Roads installations which include Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek/Fort Story, Naval Air Station Oceana, Naval Station Norfolk, Naval Support Activity Hampton Roads, and Norfolk Naval Shipyard.

Naval Weapons Station Yorktown will resume normal operations tomorrow.

All personnel are encouraged to monitor local news stations for the further updates. Personnel with specific reporting questions should contact their chain of command.
