IMPORTANT NOTICE for All Contractors

The NGA Small Business Programs Office (SBPO) collaborated with the NRO Acquisition Center of Excellence (ACE) for technology improvements to the Acquisition Research Center (ARC). Recently, we identified and subsequently implemented an IMPORTANT Capability Enhancement to the "Contractor Registry" information profile on the ARC - <u>https://arc.westfields.net</u>. The enhancement ADDS a database element (Block No. 5) for the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code identifier. This enhancement will greatly assist Contracting Officers and Program Managers identify potential sources for needed products and services when doing "Market Research".

Accordingly, it is extremely important that the Authorized Company ARC POCs update their Company Information Profile to include the NAICS identifier(s) appropriate for their business type. This can be done from any computer and should be accomplished at the earliest possible date. If further information is required please contact us at smallbusiness@nga.mil.

* If you have never had an individual account on the Internet ARC, go to https://arc.westfields.net/ <https://arc.westfields.net/>, click on Create My User Account to make an account for yourself, and then follow the site access directions given in number one above. You should use this new account that you create from this point onward whenever accessing the Internet ARC for any purpose.
