1.B. GENERAL. NO PRESIDENTIAL DISASTER DECLARATION (PDD) HAS BEEN ISSUED AS OF THE DATE OF THIS ORDER. IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE DAMAGING EFFECTS FROM THIS STORM WILL EXCEED THE CAPABILITIES OF STATE AND LOCAL EMERGENCY SERVICE AND THAT A PRESIDENTIAL DISASTER MAY BE ISSUED. IAW REF E, THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (DHS), EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE DIRECTORATE (EPR), FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA), IS THE LEAD FEDERAL AGENCY (LFA) RESPONSIBLE FOR COORDINATING THE FEDERAL RESPONSE. FEMA REGION IV IS RESPONSIBLE FOR COORDINATING FEDERAL SUPPORT IN THE STATES WHICH ARE AFFECTED BY THE STORM AND WILL ACTIVATE ITS REGIONAL RESPONSE COORDINATION CENTER (RRCC) AT ATLANTA, GA AND ASSUME LEVEL II PREPAREDNESS AS OF 25 AUG 05. PER REF S, FEMA HAS REQUESTED DEFENSE COORDINATING OFFICERS AND DEFENSE COORDINATING ELEMENTS FOR DOD SUPPORT UNDER TERMS OF THE ECONOMY ACT (REF B) AND THE NRP (REF C).//

3. EXECUTION.

3.A. COMMANDER'S INTENT.

3.A.1. PURPOSE: O/A 26 AUG 05, RAPIDLY AND EFFECTIVELY SUPPORT FEMA IN ORDER TO LESSEN THE EFFECTS OF HURRICANE KATRINA. MAINTAIN PUBLIC CONFIDENCE AND SUPPORT FOR DOD DSCA OPERATIONS.

3.A.2. METHOD. USNORTHCOM WILL PROVIDE SUPPORT TO FEMA AND ANTICIPATE REQUIREMENTS AND SUPPORT ALL DCO-VALIDATED AND SECDEF-APPROVED MISSION ASSIGNMENTS; ESTABLISH APPROPRIATE C2 TO ENSURE UNITY OF DOD EFFORT; ENSURE TAILORED FORCES COMMENSURATE WITH THE SEVERITY OF THE HURRICANE EFFECTS; CONDUCT DOD MULTI-COMPONENT AND INTERAGENCY COORDINATION TO ENSURE DOD SUPPORT IS A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT AND UTILIZATION OF DOD ASSETS IS EFFICIENT AND RESPONSIVE; ENSURE CONTINUOUS RISK MITIGATION AND FORCE PROTECTION.

3.A.3. END STATE. ALL MISSION ASSIGNMENTS PROCESSED AND COMPLETED SAFELY, EFFECTIVELY AND EFFICIENTLY. ALL DOD EXPENSES AUTHORIZED BY FEMA CAPTURED FOR REIMBURSEMENT. TACTICAL AND OPERATIONAL HANDOFF SYNCHRONIZED WITH CIVIL AGENCIES. DOD UNITS SAFELY REDEPLOYED.

PUBLIC CONFIDENCE IN DOD IS MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT HURRICANE
DISASTER
RELIEF OPERATIONS.

3.B. CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS.

3.B.1. FEMA IS THE LEAD FEDERAL AGENCY (LFA) FOR THIS DISASTER
RELIEF OPERATION. CDRUSNORTHCOM WILL PROVIDE SUPPORT TO FEMA FOR
DISASTER RESPONSE OPERATIONS IN AFFECTED AREAS OF FEMA REGIONS I, II,
III, IV, AND VI. THIS ORDER CONSTITUTES SECDEF APPROVAL FOR THE
DEPLOYMENT AND USE OF DEFENSE COORDINATING OFFICERS (DCO'S),
DEFENSE COORDINATING ELEMENTS (DCE'S), AND DOD INSTALLATIONS FOR
USE AS FEDERAL MOBILIZATION CENTERS. (EXAMPLES OF WHICH INCLUDE USE
AS AN OPERATIONAL STAGING AREA, PORT OF EMBARKATION AND/OR
DEBARKATION, DOD BASE SUPPORT INSTALLATION. HOWEVER, USING
INSTALLATIONS AS DEBRIS STORAGE OR PROCESSING CENTERS IS NOT
AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS ORDER).

3.B.1.A. PLANNING AND PREPARING FOR CONDUCT OF POTENTIAL DISASTER
RELIEF OPERATIONS. AT FEMA, ALL REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE OTHER THAN
DCO, DCE, AND DOD INSTALLATIONS WILL BE SUBMITTED TO OASD (HD),
JOINT STAFF, AND JDOMS FOR PROCESSING, VALIDATION, AND SUBSEQUENT
SECDEF ACTION. AT THE FEMA JOINT FIELD OFFICE, ALL REQUEST FOR
ASSISTANCE WILL BE VALIDATED BY THE DCO AND SUBMITTED TO
CDRUSNORTHCOM. CDRUSNORTHCOM WILL SUBMIT MISSION ASSIGNMENTS TO
JDOMS FOR OASD (HD), JOINT STAFF, AND JDOMS FOR PROCESSING,
VALIDATION, AND SUBSEQUENT SECDEF ACTION.

3.B.2. CDRUSNORTHCOM, AS THE SUPPORTED COMBATANT COMMANDER, WILL
PLAN AND EXPEDITIOUSLY CONDUCT DISASTER RELIEF SUPPORT FOR FEMA TO
INCLUDE PROVIDING PERSONNEL, UNITS, EQUIPMENT, AIRLIFT AND OTHER
SUPPORT AS REQUESTED BY FEMA. AT THE FEMA JOINT FIELD OFFICE, ALL
REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE WILL BE VALIDATED BY THE DCO AND SUBMITTED
TO
CDRUSNORTHCOM. CDRUSNORTHCOM WILL SUBMIT MISSION ASSIGNMENTS TO
JDOMS FOR OASD (HD), JOINT STAFF, AND JDOMS FOR PROCESSING,
VALIDATION, AND SUBSEQUENT SECDEF ACTION. USNORTHCOM WILL ALSO BE
PREPARED TO SUPPORT THE OFFICE OF FOREIGN DISASTER ASSISTANCE.

3.B.2.A. FEMA WILL SUBMIT A WRITTEN MISSION REQUEST(S) TO
CDRUSNORTHCOM AND THE JOINT STAFF, JOINT DIRECTOR OF MILITARY
SUPPORT (JDOMS), PROVIDING THE FOLLOWING:

3.B.2.A.1. AFFECTED OR POTENTIALLY AFFECTED LOCATIONS REQUIRING DOD
ASSISTANCE OR SUPPORT AND CAPABILITY REQUESTED (E.G., DCO OR DCE)

3.B.2.A.2. DOD INSTALLATIONS REQUESTED FOR USE AS A MOBILIZATION
CENTER EXAMPLES OF WHICH INCLUDE USE AS AN OPERATIONAL STAGING
AREA,
PORT OF EMBARKATION AND/OR DEBARKATION, DOD BASE SUPPORT

3.B.2.B. UPON CONCURRENCE OF THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT SECRETARIES, CDRUSNORTHCOM MAY APPROVE REQUESTED DCO, DCE, OR MOBILIZATION CENTER AND WILL SEND A NOTIFICATION MESSAGE TO THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, THROUGH CJCS, UPON RECEIPT OF THE MISSION REQUEST FOR THE DOD ASSETS FROM FEMA, CDRUSNORTHCOM WILL NOTIFY THE NMCC VIA THE DDO

WITH A GENADMIN MESSAGE, FOLLOWED BY E-MAIL, AND A FOLLOW-ON PHONE CALL.

3.B.2.C. CDRUSNORTHCOM WILL ACCEPT OPCON OF DOD PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT IN SUPPORT OF FEMA UPON ARRIVAL OF FORCES IN THE DISASTER SUPPORT AREA.

3.B.2.D. UPON COMPLETION OF MISSION, AS DETERMINED BY CDRUSNORTHCOM OR SECDEF, CDRUSNORTHCOM WILL TRANSFER/RELINQUISH OPCON OF REDEPLOYING PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT UPON DEPARTURE FROM THE DISASTER SUPPORT AREA.

3.B.2.E. CDRUSNORTHCOM WILL ACCEPT DEPLOYING FORCES AND EXERCISE COMMAND AND CONTROL OVER DOD PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT PROVIDING SUPPORT TO FEMA UPON ARRIVAL IN THE AFFECTED AREAS. DCO/DCE IS REQUIRED TO COORDINATE WITH FEMA REGION IV IN EVENT THE JOINT FIELD OFFICE IS NOT ESTABLISHED OR IS DISPLACED. BE PREPARED TO (BPT) PROVIDE ADDITIONAL PERSONNEL, UNITS, EQUIPMENT, AIRLIFT, AND/OR OTHER SUPPORT AS REQUESTED BY FEMA AND APPROVED BY THE SECDEF. BE PREPARED TO NOMINATE BASE SUPPORT INSTALLATIONS (BSI) AND/OR MOBILIZATION CENTER(S)/STAGING AREAS FOR DOD AND FEDERAL AGENCY SUPPORT IN THE AFFECTED AREAS.

3.B.3. CDRUSJFCOM IS A SUPPORTING COMBATANT COMMANDER AND WILL BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE PERSONNEL, UNITS EQUIPMENT, AIRLIFT AND/OR OTHER SUPPORT AS REQUESTED BY FEMA AND APPROVED BY SECDEF. TRANSFER OPCON

OF DOD PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT PROVIDING SUPPORT TO FEMA TO CDRUSNORTHCOM UPON ARRIVAL IN THE AFFECTED AREA.

3.B.4. CDRUSTRANSCOM IS A SUPPORTING COMBATANT COMMANDER AND WILL BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE PERSONNEL, UNITS, EQUIPMENT, AIRLIFT AND/OR OTHER SUPPORT AS REQUESTED BY FEMA AND APPROVED BY SECDEF.

3.B.5. SERVICES AND DEFENSE AGENCIES ARE SUPPORTING AGENCIES AND WILL BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE PERSONNEL, UNITS, EQUIPMENT, AIRLIFT AND/OR OTHER SUPPORT AS REQUESTED BY FEMA AND APPROVED BY SECDEF.

3.C. TASKING ASSIGNMENTS.

3.C.1. SECRETARY OF THE ARMY.

3.C.1.A. PROVIDE ONE (1) DCO, PER REF R 0-6 IN GRADE (OR EQUIVALENT CIVILIAN RANK) OPCON TO CDRUSNORTHCOM, COMMENCING 27 AUG 05, FOR 20 DAYS OR UNTIL MISSION COMPLETE, TO SUPPORT FEMA IN PLANNING AND CONDUCTING DISASTER RELIEF OPERATIONS IN FLORIDIA IN THE DISASTER JOINT FIELD OFFICE OR AS DIRECTED BY FEMA. THE DCO WILL SERVE AS THE SINGLE DOD POINT OF CONTACT FOR THE FEDERAL COORDINATING OFFICER

(FCO) AND FEMA WITHIN THE DISASTER AREA.

3.C.1.B. PROVIDE A DCE, COMPOSED OF APPROPRIATE STAFF ELEMENTS, COMMENCING 27 AUG 05 FOR 20 DAYS OR UNTIL MISSION IS COMPLETE TO SUPPORT THE DCO IN THE DISASTER (JOINT) FIELD OFFICES IN FLORIDIA.

3.C.1.C. BPT NOMINATE ADDITONAL INSTALLATION(S) FOR USE AS MOBILIZATION CENTER(S)/STAGING AREA(S) FOR DOD AND FEDERAL AGENCY SUPPORT IN THE AFFECTED AREAS.
