 - (1) Describe the purpose of this DoD information system or electronic collection and briefly describe the types of personal information about individuals collected in the system.

Reserve Integrated Management System (RIMS) Financial Management (FM) is a mission critical Financial Management application created to manage those funds appropriated by Congress to the Navy Reserves.

RIMS (FM) writes, modifies and cancels orders for Naval Reservists performing ACDUTRA; to issue seabags, death benefits paid, per diem, travel, subsistence, drill pay, ACDUTRA and Temporary Active Duty (TEMAC) pay, disability payments, bonuses, school costs and special pay such as flight and sea pay, and to monitor training needs.

System comprises records reflecting information pertaining to reservist's Active Duty for Training (ACDUTRA). The system also contains a Standard Document Number (SDN) which is used to track cost of training, clothing and subsistence that is provided to the reservist.

Operational Relevance: 1) Manages RPN Funds for AT, ADT, IDTT 2) Manages Reimbursable Work Orders 3) Post Obligations to STARS-FL 4) Receives Bonus information from RHS, formats and posts to STARS-FL.

PII collected: Name, Social Security Number (SSN), Rank/Grade, and Financial Information: Funding Source Code (FSC) and Standard Document Number mapped to FSC.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

Potential threats/risks that may impact the integrity, availability, and confidentially of the RIMS(FM) system includes individual users mishandling of data and firewall issues. Mitigations include: DoD PKI certificates are used for server and client authentication. Logins to the web page are controlled by the application. User authentication and role-based authorization are implemented to grant access to RIMS(FM). All external communications to the web server are protected by an external firewall, host address block / allow lists and HyperText Transfer Protocol (HTTP) of Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) encryption. An outer firewall interface will require HTTP of SSL opened inbound to the web servers. System logins are limited, in general, to administrators and developers. The RIMS(FM) production database server resides within the Data Center's Production Private Access Zone of the EDMZ - providing another level of security.
