

minutes = the minimum amount of time a person should be observed after a fall or they receive a blow, jolt to the head

**years** = the length of time Defense and Veterans Brain Injury Center has been collecting surveillance data on service members who sustained a TBI in Operation Enduring Freedom/ Operation Iraqi Freedom

**months** = the amount of time most people recover from a mild TBI

million estimated people sustain a TBI each year

30,380 275,000 servicé members were diagnosed with a mild TBI in last year

people are hospitalized annually because of a TBI

52,000 people die annually

because of a TBI

1.365 million people are treated and released annually from an emergency department 35.2 % of TBIs are a result of falls

% of all injury-related deaths in the United States have TBI as the contributing factor

% of TBIs that occur each year are concussions
