CRC BLACKBOARD COURSES:

Careerists Blackboard courses will be offered on a monthly schedule (1-30 of each month) with prior enrollment required. If you wish to enroll in a course offered for upcoming month, please access CRC Blackboard at safety.army.mil (select "training courses" from the top menu, select "on line training", scroll to bottom of page and select "launch careerist blackboard" – in order to access CRC blackboard, you will need to log in with your CAC. Follow the directions listed on the left side of the page.
