21st TSC by the Numbers: 2014

- **31,750,000:** Number of ammunition rounds 21st TSC inspected, palletized, and processed in support of Operation Inherent Resolve and the Peshmerga Military Forces in their fight against ISIS
- **6,853,000:** Approximate miles driven throughout the U.S. European Command (EUCOM) area of responsibility
- **152,976:** U.S. military personnel “transloaded” for deployment/redeployment via operations facilitated through Transit Center Mihail Kogălniceanu (TCMK), Romania
- **83,560+:** Gallons of fuel provided in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve through 4 December 14
- **79,246:** Body Armor plates inspected at TCMK, Romania since 1 February 2014
- **10,634:** Body Armor plates issued to transiting personnel at TCMK, Romania since 1 February 2014
- **3,821:** Diplomatic Clearances processed with U.S. DAO and Host Nation Officials through 41 countries in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM (OEF), EUCOM, and U.S. Africa Command (AFRICOM) operations during FY14
- **3,229:** Military personnel tracked and monitored in support of Operation Atlantic Resolve/Combined Resolve deployment/redeployment missions
- **1,777:** Soldiers tracked and monitored for Kosovo Force rotations during FY14
- **1,201:** Military personnel tracked and monitored in support of Operation ENDURING FREEDOM deployment/redeployment missions during FY14
- **1,064:** Flights (Military and Commercial) received and processed through TCMK, Romania since 1 February 2014
- **835:** Troops deployed to Afghanistan
- **735+:** Excess tactical wheeled vehicles from United States Army Europe (USAREUR) inventory turned in to support Army divestiture goals during FY14
- **668:** Highest number of 21st TSC Soldiers deployed to Afghanistan at a single time during FY14
- **461:** Contracting/funding transfers/support/acquisition actions completed for all proponents- \$376,323,926 (Kosovo, JMTC, 21st TSC, 12th CAB, 10th AAMDC, G4, G6, G8, PMO, ODCSENG, 173rd IBCT(A), SDDC, HSD, MCSD, 409th CSB, 903rd CCBn, BS-AST)
- **211:** Coalition forces personnel “transloaded” for deployment/redeployment via operations facilitated through TCMK, Romania since 1 February 2014
- **209:** Number of 21st TSC Military Police on patrol during a typical day
- **160:** Number of Operation UNITED ASSISTANCE-Liberia personnel monitored for 21 days through Controlled Monitoring Area (CMA) –Baumholder, under 21st TSC Mission Command
- **93:** Number of 21st TSC personnel deployed to West Africa in support of counter-Ebola efforts under Operation UNITED ASSISTANCE
- **32:** Exercises and partner building events across the EUCOM and AFRICOM areas of operation supported by 21st TSC during FY14
- **22:** Number of multinational exercises with European ally and partner nation personnel scheduled for FY15
- **9:** Army Post Offices (APO) providing distribution and registered mail support operated by 21st TSC personnel
- **6:** U.S. Combatant Commands supported by the 21st TSC (in addition to NATO): U.S. European Command (EUCOM), U.S. Africa Command (AFRICOM), U.S. Central Command (CENTCOM), U.S. Transportation Command (TRANSCOM), U.S. Strategic Command (STRATCOM), and U.S. Special Operations Command (SOCOM)
