

## Sample CO Report

The NMCPHC Workplace HRA measures lifestyle behaviors that are most commonly associated with adverse health outcomes. Individuals who took the HRA have been provided written feedback within a Participant's Report. Each report provided factual information, recommendations, and encouragement to seek additional support when appropriate. Members were scored as high, medium, or low risk based on the number of risk behaviors they reported. The Commanding Officer's Report provides a consolidated report of HRA records completed for any workplace (based on UIC or OPFAC numbers) and any time period you specify. This report may be useful for focused delivery of workplace health promotion efforts. It reports participant responses as either "Unhealthy" or "Healthy". "Unhealthy" includes any significant degree of risk, while "Healthy" includes low-risk behaviors as well as health promoting behaviors.
