Traci L. Clever, PMP, SES South Pacific Division Director for Regional Business



Ms. Traci L. Clever was selected to the Senior Executive Service in August 2013 in the position of Regional Business Director for the South Pacific Division, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Established in 1888, the South Pacific Division comprises one-fifth of the United States and is one of the Corps' eight regional commands. The Division includes four operating districts headquartered in Albuquerque, Los Angeles, Sacramento and San Francisco.

Ms. Clever serves as a principal advisor to the Commanding General and provides executive leadership and direction for the Division and its four subordinate districts to operate as a Regional Business Center. She is responsible for strategic direction, business transformation, strategic communication, planning and policy, real estate, and financial management for a \$2.0 billion average annual program and an organization that includes approximately 2,500 active duty military and civilians.

She directly oversees the Business Resource Division, which provides regional finance and accounting, budget, manpower and management support; Business Management Division, which provides regional governance and strategic planning; Planning and Policy Division, which provides technical plan formulation, economics and environmental expertise, advice and direction on all regional Civil Works projects; and Real Estate Division, which supports both Civil Works and Military Programs mission requirements. Technical and policy challenges revolve around the balance between water and ecosystem management for safety, flood risk reduction and navigation. South Pacific Division overseas 46 dams and reservoirs, 27 federal ports and harbors, 2,286 miles of federal levees, and 29 recreation areas in an region with more than 300 threatened or endangered species.
