Feasibility (CAP Section 205)

Location: Marquand, Missouri, is located 100 miles south of St. Louis on State Highway A and about 45 miles west of Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

Description: The city of Marquand, Missouri, is currently experiencing flooding along Whitener Creek and Castor River.

Issues: The project will examine alternatives to reduce flooding along Whitener Creek and Castor River.

Importance: With project and funding, there is potential to reduce flooding impacts to community along Whitener Creek and Castor River.

Risk: Without funding and project, area is at risk of flooding.

Consequence: Without project, city will continue to be at risk of flooding from Whitener Creek and Castor River.
