- The Kansas City District's estimating capability consists of 7 certified cost estimators of varying disciplines with each estimator having at least 10 years of experience. One staff member is an instructor for the Corps' Cost Estimating Basics Course.
- Estimates are made on a variety of project types including:
  - New building construction
  - Rehabilitation type work
  - Remodeling including asbestos abatement and lead based paint removal
  - Utilities
  - Demolition
  - Roadways & parking
  - Large earthwork projects
  - Hazardous, Toxic, and Radiological Waste cleanups
  - Underground Storage Tank removal
  - Operation and Maintenance of treatment facilities
- Estimate Costs range from under \$25,000 to \$100 million plus.
- Estimates can be made for any stage of design
  - Preconcept Parametric estimating is used when virtually no information about the design is known. A minimum amount of information is required to generate costs using computer modeling. When more information is known a more refined cost estimate can be obtained.
  - Fully Designed Detailed quantity takeoffs are performed. Each item is priced with labor, equipment, and material unit costs. A determination of which work is to be subcontracted is made and appropriate overheads and profits are applied to develop the total contract cost.
- Estimates can be made from a variety of media
  - Pencil and Paper
  - Spreadsheet
