The Battalion Headquarters Building 7615 is one of the Kansas City District's standard design facilities constructed as part of the FY10 Brigade Transformation project at Fort Riley, Kansas. This Army Standard Design compliant, medium Battalion Headquarters consists of 16,400 square feet of administrative and classroom space with supporting site work improvements.

Project requirements included:

- initial site investigations & building demolition
- development of a 100% design for the new building and site improvements
- comprehensive interior design services
- LEED documentation package
- technical specifications
- award and administration of the construction contract for the facility

This adapt-build application of the Battalion Headquarters standard design was executed with a combined in-house design and AE team utilizing Building Information Modeling.

The Battalion headquarters, Building 7615 was completed in September 2011 for a construction contract amount of \$6 million.
