The Brigade Headquarters Building 7232 is one of seven facilities constructed as part of the FY09 Brigade Transformation Complex project at Fort Riley, Kansas. Project requirements included site investigations, development of a request for proposal and the award and administration of the design-build construction contract for the facility.

This Army Standard Design compliant, large Brigade Headquarters consists of 40,000 square feet of administrative

and operational space with supporting site work improvements. The facility provides for the functional and operational requirements for brigade level command, personnel, intelligence, operations, supply, communications and other specialized headquarters functions. The Army Standard Design applies to Active, Reserve and National Guard Component facilities on Army installations.

The Brigade Headquarters Building 7232 at Fort Riley was completed in February 2011 for a construction contract amount of \$10.7 million.
