The Kansas City District’s design services provide a customer-focused emphasis on professional interior design services and a growing need to support Headquarters, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Building related interior design services include: color coordinating materials; meeting interior furnishing technical specifications; providing color boards; space planning; providing renderings and drawings; floor and wall pattern design; and signage. Furniture-related interior design services include: furniture programming estimates; selection recommendations; proposing furniture layout; completing order forms; artwork; and window treatments.

Kansas City District Interior Design Services Overview:

- Employs 4 Registered Commercial Interior Designers
- Employs 3 LEED Accredited Professionals
- Offers Building Information Modeling trained professionals in MicroStation and Revit software
- Experience in designing a variety of facilities: administrative buildings; training centers; barracks; dining halls; maintenance facilities; and ranges
- Provides Comprehensive Interior Design packages for the following customers: Fort Riley, Kansas; Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri; Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington; Lake City Army Ammunition Plant, Missouri
- Strives to work closely with customer and building users during design to create space data sheets, verifying functional requirements
- Familiar with integrating technology and secure communication equipment into training/ conference rooms and workspaces, including Secure Compartmented Information Facilities – SCIFs)
- Experience working with field offices and contractors to review submittals and Requests for Information
- Provides reviews of procurement documents verifying that the furniture is accurately specified by the manufacturer
- Maintains excellent relationships by working closely with the designers and contracting officials at the Huntsville Centralized Army Furniture Procurement Program
- Experience specifying furniture, fixtures and equipment to be procured as part of the construction contract for non-Army customers and building renovations
- Maintains involvement in the entire process from design through construction and installation of furniture, fixtures and equipment to ensure the aesthetic and functional requirements are satisfied
