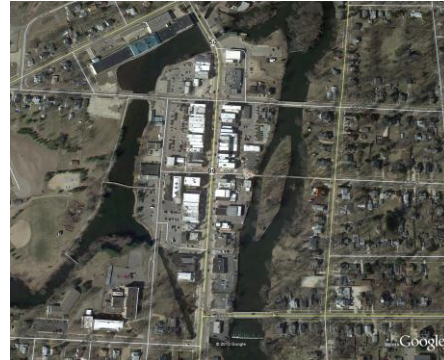
Description
