# **Description**

Muskegon Lake is located on the eastern shore of Lake Michigan approximately 42 miles northwest of Grand Rapids Michigan. The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) requested the Corps' assistance in site assessment and a developing remediation plan for an abandoned fuel refinery. This work will help to remove some of the beneficial use impairments that are associated with the Muskegon Lake Area of Concern (AOC) and go towards delisting Muskegon Lake as an AOC.
