Description

Oakland County, MI Oakland County is located in southeastern Michigan and includes a northern portion of the Detroit metropoitan area. This project implements the George W. Kuhn Combined Sewer Overflow Program, which includes numerous improvements to the existing system. The entire George W. Kuhn Drainage Improvement Project will be implemented through multiple construction contracts with a total cost of approximately \$144 million. The USACE has received a \$20 million authority to assist with infrastructure improvements. This element of the program consists of sewer cleaning, CIPP lining and joint repairs.
