C-GLFER-Salt River Marsh Coastal Habitat Restoration, MI

Description

The Salt River is located in Chesterfield Township, Macomb County, Michigan. This project will restore and protect the Salt River Marsh near Anchor Bay in Lake St. Clair. The project area has been heavily infested with the invasive Phragmites plant, which chokes out other vegetation and fills in fish spawning habitat. The project area would be dredged to remove the Phragmites and restore depths in the Salt River. The project will be linked with a recreational/educational project being developed just downstream by Macomb County.
