Description

The project location is a former navigation channel in the Milwaukee Estuary, within Milwaukee, WI. Through the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) Program, the Non-Federal Sponsor has asked for assistance with Plans and Specifications to design a near shore wetland habitat in a former navigation channel in Milwaukee Estuary Area of Concern (AOC). USACE will provide the design to cap the contaminated sediment base with an impermeable cap and a create a wetland habitat environment. Project execution will be by Non-Federal Sponsor.
