Description

Honey Creek is a small subwatershed of the larger Menomonee River watershed, located in southeast Wisconsin in the Milwaukee metropolitan area. The Project area is a 3,700 lineal feet (LF) reach of the Honey Creek in the area from approximately 500 feet upstream of Portland Avenue to the North Honey Creek Parkway crossing south of West Bluemound Road in Wauwatosa and Milwaukee, Wisconsin. This reach consists of a concrete channel that was installed as part of a flood reduction project built by the MMSD and Milwaukee County in the 1960's and it provides extremely limited habitat value.
