# CCC – State Agency

- Employs young adults 18 – 25
- Crews trained in DWR Flood Fighting Techniques.
- 9 million hours of emergency response -- floods, fires, earthquakes, oil spills, agricultural pests and more.
- Floods -- Corpsmembers have braved nearly every major flood since 1977, including the El Niño storms of 1998.
- CCC crews fill sandbags, protect and reinforce levees and stabilize hillsides. Since 1977, the CCC has filled more than three million sandbags.



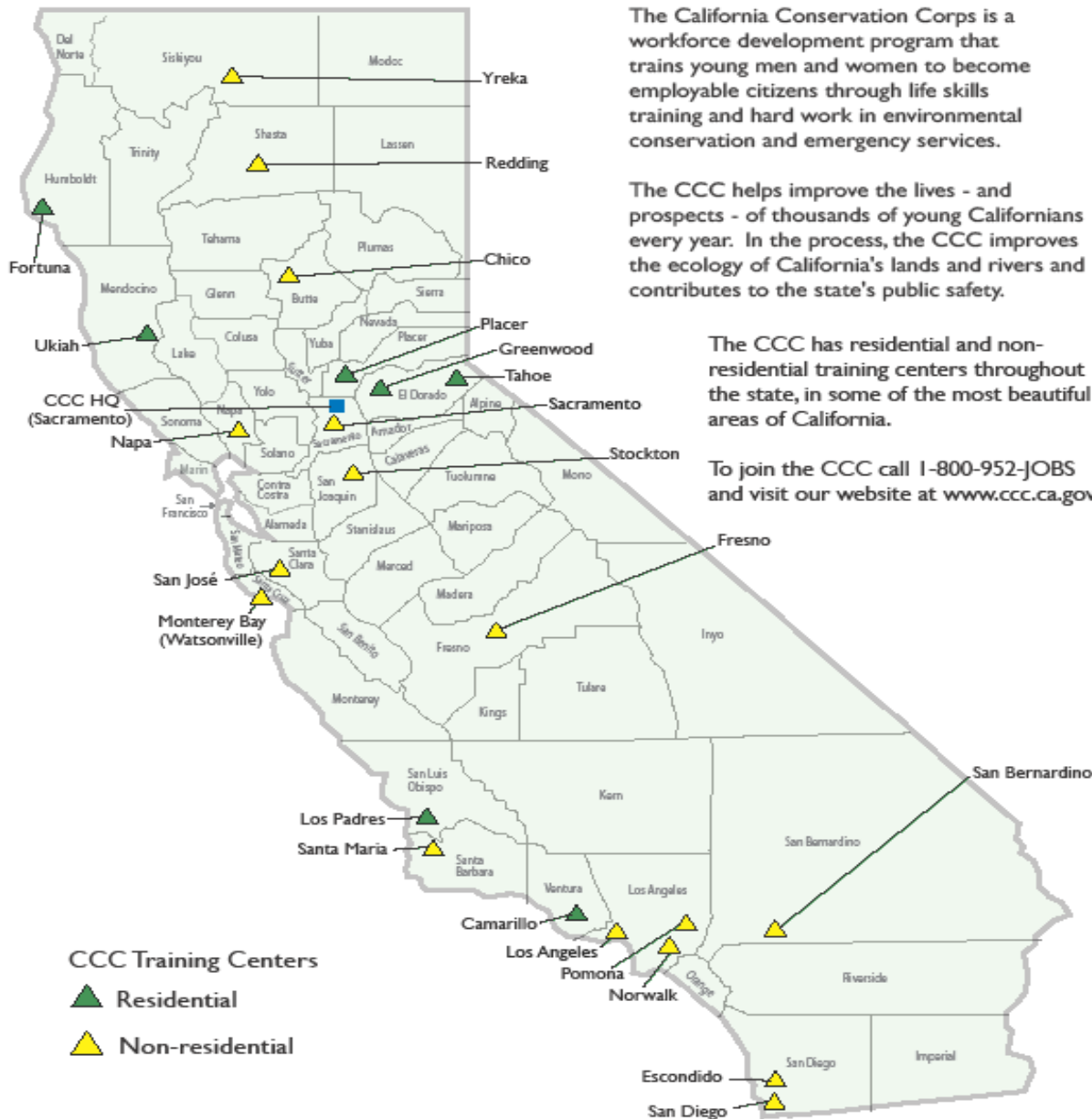
# California Conservation Corps

**Contracting with the CCC can provide your agency :**

- Assist with Flood Prevention, Mitigation or Flood Response
- Provide CCC Flood Crew Rapid Response (1 or multiple crews)
- CCC works closely with Host Agency or can operate under ICS
- Crews are self contained with transportation, tools and supervision
- CCC personnel are covered under the States workers compensation
- Can develop contract agreement to fit your needs and only activate if needed for flood response.
