



	American River Common Features: 22 miles of seepage and stability improvements along the American River.
	Folsom Dam JFP and Dam Raise: Auxiliary spillway. Construction complete in 2017. Folsom Dam Raise complete in 2022.
	Sacramento River Bank Protection Project (Sac Bank): Repair critical erosion sites.
	Sacramento Metropolitan Urban Area Project (Sac Urban): Through-seepage problems on the east levee of Sacramento River addressed with cutoff wall.
	South Sacramento Streams Project (South Sac): Improvements to Morrison Creek, Florin Creek, Elder Creek, and Unionhouse Creek included construction of new levees and floodwalls, channel widening, and erosion protection.
	Natomas Levee Improvement Project (NLIP): Improvements addressed seepage, stability, and height and included construction of an adjacent levee, a deep seepage cutoff wall and/or a seepage berm, slope flattening and levee raising.
	North Area Local Project (NALP): Improvements included levee raising and new north levee of Dry/Robla Creek.
	West Sacramento: Improvements to the east levee of the Yolo Bypass addressed stability and levee geometry issues.
