NAVIGATION NOTICE NO. 2014-NH-002

ATLANTIC CHANNELS,
ATLANTIC HARBOR OF REFUGE
REACH 2

A hazard to navigation exists in the Atlantic Harbor of Refuge at Reach 2 (authorized depth -7 ft.) near Atlantic, NC. Severe shoaling restricts the channel between US Coast Guard buoys 4 & 6. Conditions in this area are shallower than -1.5 ft across the Federal Navigation Channel at Mean Low Water.

Mariners are urged to transit at their slowest safe speed and proceed with extreme caution.
