Her areas of responsibility included strategic workforce planning, manpower, information analytics, metrics, organizational development & design, HD policy and instructions, employee climate survey, centralized position management, oversight and management of performance pay, performance management, occupational advancement & developmental program promotion process, monetary/time-off award budgets, and compensation processes across NGA.

She also served as NGA's Security and Installation Operations Directorate's Director of Installation Operations. She was responsible for managing operations at two major NGA installations, to include engineering and construction, facility operation and maintenance, logistics, emergency management, force protection, conference center management, general administration, physical security, and medical and food services.

Ms. Snyder previously served as the Architect of the Capitol's Director of Congressional and External Relations.

Ms. Snyder served 25 years active duty in the U.S. Air Force where she held multiple leadership positions at the installation level, Major Command, Headquarters Air Force, Air Force Secretariat, and the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
