Subj: ORDER CONVENING THE FY-16 SPECIALTY CAREER PATH (SCP) SELECTION

Ref: (a) FY-16 Administrative Selection Board Precept

1. Date and Location

a. This administrative selection board, consisting of you as the president and the members listed in enclosure (1), is ordered to convene at Navy Personnel Command, Millington, TN, at 0800, 27 July 2015, or as soon as practicable thereafter.

b. The board shall proceed in accordance with all guidance in this letter and the FY-16 Administrative Selection Board Precept, reference (a).

2. Function. The function of the board is to:

- a. Screen officers in the 1110, 1120, 1140, 1310 and 1320 designators as Specialty Career Path (SCP) officers in 1 of 10 SCP disciplines;
- b. Screen designated SCP officers as Specialty Career Path-Commanding Officer (SCP-CO) and Specialty Career Path-Executive Officer (SCP-XO);
- c. Conduct a bank review of SCP officers previously screened as SCP-XO and SCP-CO.

3. Board Authorized Selections

a. The maximum number of officers that may be selected for SCP designation at this board is provided in Table 1. Officers who have applied for more than one discipline will have their record reviewed for each specialty for which they have applied. After each record has been briefed and voted, you will then assign officers to each specific discipline based on their personal preferences, their skill sets, and the needs of the Navy.

- (1) The maximum number selected should only be attained if there are a sufficient number of officers determined as meeting best and fully qualified criteria.
 - (2) To be qualified for selection, officers must:
- (a) Be on active duty, not currently being processed for administrative separation, not the subject of a pending detachment for cause, previously detached for cause, or previously selected for an SCP discipline;
- (b) Have submitted an application request for SCP designation;
- (c) Meet the following entry time for designator as listed in paragraph 4.b. $\,$
- b. The maximum number of officers that may be selected for SCP-CO and SCP-XO at this board is provided in Table 2. This quota is based on the total number of SCP-CO and SCP-XO billets within each discipline, the current number of SCP designated officers in the SCP-CO and SCP-XO banks, and accounts for an unlimited number of looks for SCP-CO and SCP-XO within a career.

- (1) The maximum number selected should only be attained if there are a sufficient number of officers determined as meeting best and fully qualified.
- (2) To be qualified for selection, officers must have already been selected for one of the 10 SCP disciplines, or selected by this board.
- (3) To be eligible for SCP-CO, officers must possess a 2D1 additional qualification designation.
- 4. <u>Additional Guidance</u>. The below information is provided to clarify community requirements and any specific needs, but in no way should replace the Best and Fully Qualified Standard of reference (a).
- a. Specialty Career Path Disciplines. The SCP program provides alternatives to the traditional command-at-sea career path and supports the demand for Unrestricted Line (URL) Lieutenant Commander, Commander and Captain experience in critical mission areas. Eligible officers will be selected for one of the following 10 SCP disciplines:
 - (1) Missile Defense (MD)
 - (2) Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection (ATFP)
 - (3) Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW)
 - (4) Mine Warfare (MIW)
 - (5) Shore Installation Management (SIM)
 - (6) Strategic Sealift (SS)
 - (7) Operations Analysis (OA)
 - (8) Financial Management (FM)
 - (9) Naval Operational Planner (NOP)
 - (10) Education and Training Management (ETMS)
- b. Eligibility Requirements. Officers desiring to enter one of the SCP disciplines may do so at the following career points per designator:
- (1) 1110 Upon completion of the first Department Head (DH) tour or upon completion of the first 18 months of a single longer DH tour.
- (2) 1120 After final look for Executive Officer and not serving or required to serve in Submarine Support Assignment as determined by the Officer Community Manager.
 - (3) 1130 Not eligible for the FY-16 SCP selection board.

- (4) 1140 When all administrative screening opportunities for explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) warfare XO have been completed. Eligible officers may only apply for either the mine warfare or naval operational planner career paths. (SCP program will not impact the EOD warfare LCDR CSRB).
- (5) 1310/1320 Upon completion of a DH tour, or failure to select for a DH tour for the second time.
- c. Discipline Selection. Officers interested in more than one discipline may submit a prioritized list. Officers will only be selected for one discipline from their list of specialty options they provide. This board will select the best and fully qualified officers to serve the needs of the Navy in each of the disciplines; however, due consideration should be given to the applicant's preference and the needs of the Navy when determining the discipline for which they are selected.
- d. SCP Milestones. Designated SCP officers will be considered for SCP-CO and SCP-XO screening. Commanders and commander selects will be considered for SCP-CO; lieutenant commanders and lieutenant commander selects will be considered for SCP-XO. Each SCP discipline board will review the records of all previously unscreened for XO or CO as appropriate SCP officers and select the best and fully qualified. There is no limit to the number of times an SCP officer can be considered for SCP-CO or SCP-XO screening. Selection for SCP-CO and SCP-XO does not guarantee slating to SCP-CO and SCP-XO equivalent billets, but will depend upon individual PRDs and billet availability.
- e. Performance and Experience. Officers should be considered based upon the quality of their performance at the commands to which they are assigned. While it is important to factor in education and experience when determining which officers are the best fit for a specified discipline, there should be a premium placed on sustained performance in milestone or operational billets.
- 5. The board need not select to the numbers provided. The authorized number to select should only be attained if there are a sufficient number of candidates determined fully qualified.
