MARQUAT MEMORIAL LEARNING RESOURCE CENTER (LRC)

The Marquat Memorial Learning Resource Center, or LRC, serves as the headquarters library supporting USASJFKSWCS. The Joint Special Operations Medical Training Center Library is the medical library supporting the Special Warfare Medical Group.

MARQUAT MEMORIAL LRC

The Marquat Memorial LRC houses more than 39,000 titles, plus DVDs, PlayAways, journals, newspapers and foreign-language materials. In addition to 14 computer workstations, a flatbed scanner and fax, the LRC manages access to premium online resources. Training on use of these resources is available by calling (910) 396-5370 or asking for help at the Circulation Desk.

THE JSOMTC LIBRARY

The JSOMTC Library has more than 1,700 medical books, 17 specialized medical journals, medical foreign-language materials, 13 computer workstations, a flatbed scanner and fax.

The LRC specializes in reference and research supporting the educational, training, doctrinal, and operational research requirements of USAJFKSWCS and the United States Army Special Operations Command. The LRC provides access to fee-based databases. All USASOC subordinate units are authorized access to these resources, as are students currently enrolled in SWCS courses.
