- 3. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION.

A. THE USAJFKSWCS HAS PARTNERED WITH THE NDU TO OFFER A FULLY ACCREDITED, TEN MONTH, MASTER OF ARTS IN STRATEGIC SECURITY STUDIES AT FORT BRAGG, NORTH CAROLINA. THE MASTER OF ARTS PROGRAM MIRRORS THE JOINT SPECIAL OPERATIONS MASTER OF ARTS OFFERED BY NDU'S COLLEGE OF INTERNATIONAL SECURITY AFFAIRS. THE JOINT SPECIAL OPERATIONS PROGRAM OFFERS A CURRICULUM INCORPORATING THE STRATEGIC PERSPECTIVE ON THE GLOBAL THREAT ENVIRONMENT; THE RISE OF NEWLY EMPOWERED AND POLITICIZED IDEOLOGICAL MOVEMENTS; THE RELATIONSHIPS AMONG POLITICAL OBJECTIVES, STRATEGY, ALL INSTRUMENTS OF NATIONAL POWER; AND THE ROLES OF POWER AND IDEOLOGY. THE DEGREE IS COMPLETED THROUGH A COMBINATION OF THEORETICAL AND PRACTICAL LEARNING INCLUDING SEMINAR PARTICIPATION, INDEPENDENT STUDY, RESEARCH, AND WRITING OF A THESIS.
