COL Sandy Vann-Olejasz is the PEO EIS Military Deputy, working strategic actions for the PEO.

COL Vann-Olejasz has served in a variety of acquisition positions during her military career. Most recently, she served as Project Manager, DoD Biometrics and was responsible for two Acquisition Category I Special Interest programs: Biometric Enabling Capabilities and Joint Personnel Identification version 2. She also served as the Executive Officer for the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics, and Technology). COL Vann-Olejasz was assigned to PEO Command, Control and Communications - Tactical as the Assistant Product Manager for the Battle Command Sustainment Support System and then to PEO EIS as the Product Manager, Army Enterprise Systems Integration Program.

COL Vann-Olejasz has also served in a variety of command and staff positions. She was a platoon leader in support of Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm for the 493rd Supply and Service Company. In Germany, she was the Support Operations Officer and Battalion S-4 for the 203rd Forward Support Battalion, 3rd Infantry Division. She served as the S-1 of the 701st Main Support Battalion (MSB), 1st Infantry Division at Fort Riley, Kansas and then commanded Charlie Company, 701st MSB. Also at Fort Riley, she was the S-1 of the 937th Engineer Group and S-3 of the 541st Maintenance Battalion. After graduate school, she served as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Systems Engineering at the United States Military Academy at West Point (USMA) and as the Deputy Director of West Point's Operations Research Center.

COL Vann-Olejasz received a BS in Computer Science from USMA where she was commissioned in the Quartermaster Corps upon graduation. She also holds an MBA from Georgetown University, and an MS in National Resource Strategy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces.
