BDD 180 to 60 Days before ETS/RET – Quick Start 59 days of less before ETS/RET

If you are planning to leave active duty service soon, you can begin the process of obtaining your VA Disability rating by filing your claim here at Fort Knox. The following checklist will help you compile the documents that you will need to file your claim (some may not apply to you).

PRO	DESS: When you have a known date of separation Bring your documentation, (including all military or civilian medical records that you would like the VA to consider as evidence in your claim) to one of the VA Claims workshops listed below.
h	Direct deposit information bank name, routing and account # (voided check is a good idea)
g	Marriage license (current)
f	All divorce decrees for spouse and self (if applicable)
e	Copies of prior DD214's and current retirement / ets orders if available
d	Social security numbers for spouse and <i>dependent</i> children
C	Copies of birth certificates for all <i>dependent</i> children
b	Copies of all AGR orders maintaining you on active duty (if AGR)
	CD (digital records) or printed copies of all medical records covering all active duty periods and branches of service. (We keep CD and / or printed)
