•	Fast for 6-8 hours prior to the exam; ONLY sips of water if necessary to take medication. If the patient is a child younger than 6 years, they only need to fast for 4 hours. If the patient is diabetic, they may have diabetic candy or orange juice if they feel their sugar is low but they should otherwise continue to fast.

•	Drink water (24-32 ounces for pelvic, and 16-20 ounces for renal bladder, and obstetrical) finishing 30 minutes prior to the exam. PLEASE DO NOT EMPTY YOUR BLADDER. If you need to go to the bathroom, please notify the front desk.

- If patient is younger than 50 years or pre-menopausal, a URINE PREGNANCY TEST IS REQUIRED ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE EXAM.
- The exam must be scheduled for 5-10 days after the first day of the menstrual cycle.
