□ Sports bra (females)	□ Tan T-shirt, 1 extra (no logos or name)
□ ID tags with long and short chain (around neck with medical alert tag)	☐ Field jacket / gore-tex jacket with all patches and tapes (no leadership tab)
□ ID card (in left or right chest pocket)	☐ Gloves, black / green leather shell, military issue

□ ACH / Kevlar helmet (no cover)	□ 2 3 x 5 index cards (One used as a Casualty Feeder Card, One for 10 layout; no lines
□ Waterproof bag, military issue (marked with shoe tag with name and unit)	□ Poncho
□ Wet weather top with rank (summer) / field jacket or gore-tex with all patches and tapes (winter)	□ Goggles (clear lenses with retaining strap, form fitting to face)
□ ACU top (sterile)	□ Air Assault Handbook (when issued)
□ ACU trousers	□ Advance sheets (when issued)
□ 1 tan T-shirt (no logos or name)	□ 1-qt canteen carrier with canteen cup on IBA (guide hand side)
□ 1 pair of socks no logos must be matching (black or green military issue)	☐ Flashlight, right angle with red lens (with D-cell batteries only)
□ Neck gaiter, military issue, black or brown (no hood)	□ Gloves, black / green leather shell, military issue
□ Ear plugs with case, military issue	☐ Glove inserts, military issue, black, green, or brown (no synthetic or polypro)
	□ PT cap, foliage green
Additional Equipment	Required
□ APFU pants	□ White socks (above the ankle bone, no logos, no tube socks)
□ APFU jacket	☐ Field jacket liner or heavy weight polypro top (winter)
□ APFU shorts	□ Beret (Graduation Day only)
□ APFU shirt (long sleeve and short sleeve)	□ Cold weather boots (winter)
	□ Polypro bottoms (winter)

Notes:

Service Members not in the U.S. Army should wear authorized uniforms by specific branch of service; duty & physical fitness uniforms.

Winter classes are classes with Day Zero beginning between 1 October thru 31 March.

All equipment must be serviceable.



IBA AND ASSAULT PACK PACKING LIST AND LAYOUT

- 1) ASSAULT PACK ON BACK W/ PT BELT PLACED VERTICALLY AROUND ASSAULT PACK (ALL STRAPS FASTNED AND EXCESS SECURED)
- 2) IBA WITH CANTEEN CARRIER, CANTEEN CUP, NAME TAPE, RANK AND PLATES (WORN, NO ADDITIONAL POUCHES)
- 3) PONCHO (FOLDED IN ½ AND THEN ½ AGAIN)
- 4) WET WEATHER TOP (SUMMER)
 GORTEX / FIELD JACKET(WINTER)
- 5) ACU BOTTOM
- 6) ACU TOP STERILE (SEW ON MUST HAVE ALL PATCHES AS WORN)
- 7) 1 TAN T-SHIRT (NO LOGOS/UNIT T-SHIRTS)
- 8) PATROL CAP (W/NAME TAPE AND RANK)
- 9) GOGGLES (CLEAR LENSES WITH RETAINING STRAP)
- 10) ZIP-LOCK BAG
- 11) ID CARD (FACING INSTRUCTOR)
- 12) NOTEPAD
- 13) PEN AND HIGHLIGHTER
- 14) 1 QT. CANTEEN (COMPLETELY FULL, ROSTER # FACE UP)
- 15) HELMET (AS WORN, CHIN STRAP SECURED)
- 16) WET WEATHER BAG (FOLDED IN ½ THEN ½ AGAIN)
- 17) BLACK LEATHER WORK GLOVES (THUMBSTOWARDS INSTRUCTOR, PALMS TOGETHER)
- 18) MILITARY ISSUED INSERTS (THUMBS TOWARDS INSTRUCTOR)
- 19) 1 PAIR OF SOCKS, MATCHING BLACK OR GREEN MILITARY ISSUE (HEELS TOWARDS CENTER)
- 20) LAYOUT DIAGRAM SHEET (FACING INSTRUCTOR)
- 21) AASLT HANDBOOK & ADVANCE SHEETS (12M FM LAYOUT)
- 22) 3 X 5 CARD (COMPLETE & ACCURATE INFORMATION)
- 23) PT CAP (FOLIAGE GREEN FLEECE CAP) FOLDED IN ½
- 24) NECK GAITER (FOLDED IN ½)
- 25) EAR PLUGS IN CASE (CASE OPEN)
- 26) 2 RED CHEMUGHTS (NO BATTERY OPERATED CHEMUGHTS)
- 27) 3X5 CARD USED AS A CASUALTY FEEDER CARD




