## DEVELOPMENT OF THE NATIONAL GUARD STRATEGY

1. Purpose. This notice provides interim guidance for the development of the National Guard Strategy (NGS) in accordance with (IAW) the references.
  2. Cancellation. None.
  3. Applicability. This notice applies to all elements of the National Guard.
  4. Background. The Chief of the National Guard Bureau (CNGB) approved the National Guard Strategic Planning System (NGSPS) concept on 04 April 2013. The NGS is a core component of the NGSPS, and will support the CNGB and NGB in fulfilling their roles and responsibilities IAW references a and b.
  5. Action or Procedure.
    - a. The Director of Strategic Plans, Policy, and International Affairs (NG-J5) is the sponsor for the NGS and will lead efforts to coordinate, prepare, staff, and publish the strategy.
    - b. All other NGB offices will coordinate on the NGS when requested by the Director of NG-J5.
