MEMORANDUM FOR Family and Friends of Charlie Battery, 1-79 FA Soldiers

SUBJECT: REAL ID ACT of 2005

The REAL ID Act of 2005 establishes minimum standards for the production and issuance of state-issued driver licenses and identification cards that include requirements for a photograph and certain biographic information. Under the REAL ID Act, state-issued driver licenses and identification (ID) cards from **New Mexico**, **Minnesota**, **Washington**, **Missouri** and **Illinois** not meeting the standard. Therefore, residents of those states who are visitors to Fort Sill must bring with them an alternative form of identification in order to access the installation. These alternative identifications do not negate the need for a driver's license in order to operate a vehicle. Acceptable alternative forms of identification for access to Fort Sill are

- US passport
- Permanent Resident/Alien Reg Card
- Foreign passport
- Employment authorization document
- US Military ID
- Border Crossing Card
- US military draft record
- US Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- Native American Tribal document
- PIV and PIV-I Card
- ID Card issued by Federal, State or Local Government Agency
- Veterans Affairs ID Card
- Select University, library or school photo ID w/name & expiration date
- Non-Government Photo ID with name & address
- Birth Certificate or Other Document w/full name & date of birth
- Utility Bill or other documentation showing person's name & address of principle residence
- Vehicle Registration w/name & address
