What is the status of sidewalks on Rockenbach Avenue – especially near schools?	AACPS Transportation Office does not recommend sidewalks at the location unless a crossing guard would be present.	Closed
Building T4 has an issue when it rains, the building leaks; there may be a problem with mold under the carpet.	Temporary drainage repairs made around the perimeter of the building to address leaks and the floor in the meeting area has been repaired. Additional repairs are needed to make the building acceptable for public use. Repairs are on hold pending a decision whether to fund the work. Options for alternative space have been identified and we are awaiting space to be vacated to offer the space to private organizations. (No change)	Open
