



FGGM 2013 SNOW REMOVAL PLAN (DPW)

Objective: Clear snow and ice from surfaces within allotted time to ensure treated surfaces are safe and passable for pedestrian and vehicular traffic in support of FGGM's operations

Three Priority Levels:

- 1. Primary roads and emergency access areas –accessible at all times.
- 2. Secondary roads, parking areas, walkways, and building entrances cleared within (6) hours <u>after the end of precipitation.</u>
- 3. Tertiary roads, parking areas, storm water management structures and traffic safety –Completed within 12 hours <u>after the end of precipitation</u>.
