Sleep is Important at All Ages

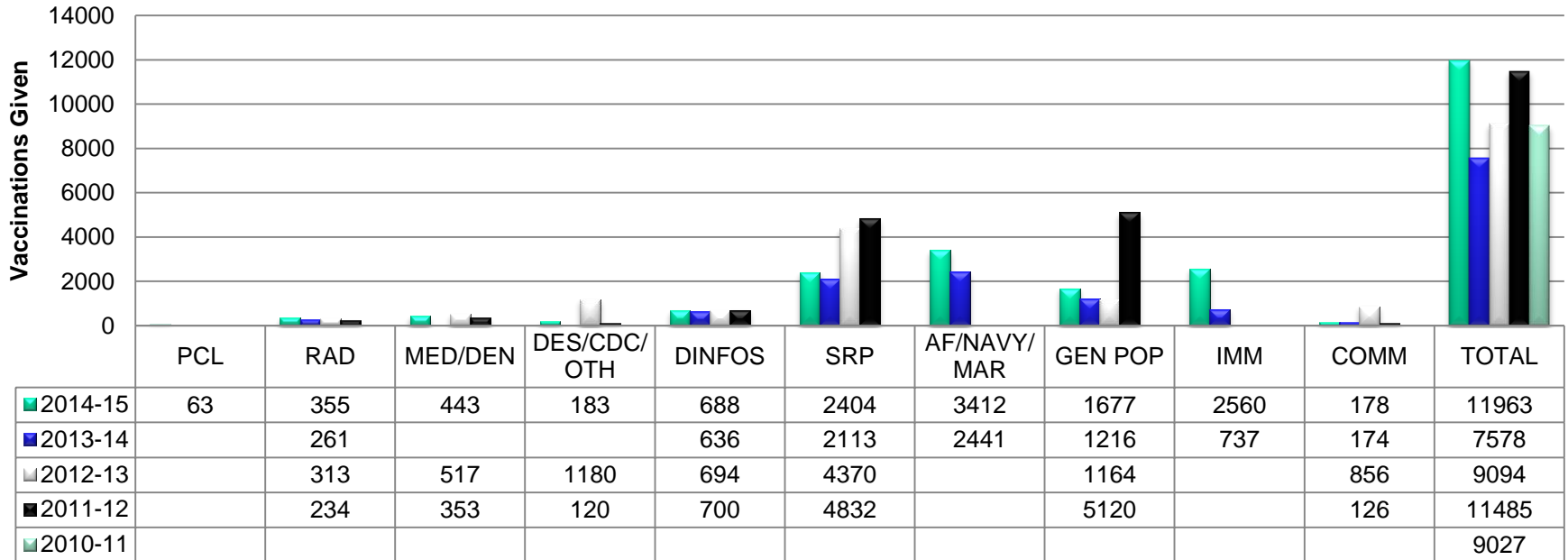
| Ages | Requirement |
|----------------------------------|----------------------|
| Newborns (0-3 months) | 14-17 hours of sleep |
| Infants (4-11 months) | 12-15 hours of sleep |
| Toddlers (1-2 years) | 11-14 hours of sleep |
| Preschoolers (3-5 years) | 10-13 hours of sleep |
| School Age Children (6-13 years) | 9-11 hours of sleep |
| Teens (14-17 years) | 8-10 hours of sleep |
| Younger adults (18-25 years) | 7-9 hours of sleep |
| Adults (26-64 years) | 7-9 hours of sleep |
| Older Adults (65+ years) | 7-8 hours of sleep |
