

III Corp Aviation Safety & Standardization Bulletin 16-04

SUBJECT: Change to FH95-1 Reference Hood Army Airfield Helipads.

- 1. Background. Unified Facilities Criteria 3-260-01, requires helipads be no more than 700 feet from the centerline of the runway unless non-simultaneous operations are being conducted, then the distance can be reduced to no less than 200 feet. H-2 is approximately 400 feet from the runway centerline.
- 2. Change FH 95-1 dated 9 May 2016 paragraph 2-12,a.(5) to read as follows:

Due to the proximity of Helipad 2 to the runway, simultaneous operations to the runway within 700 feet of H-2 are prohibited when H-2 is occupied and operations to H-2 are prohibited when aircraft are within 700 feet on the runway. H-2 is designated as a limited use Visual Flight Rules (VFR) helipad. Cargo Helicopter (CH) 47's are restricted from landing at this helipad, however they may land west of H-2 on Taxiway G.
