SUBJECT: Off Limits Establishments/Area

1. References:

- a. AR 190-24, Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards (AFDCB) and Off Installation Liaison and Operations, 27 July 2006.
 - b. AR 11-2, Management Control, 26 March 2012.
 - c. AR 195-2, Criminal Investigation Activities, 9 June 2014.
- d. AR 380-13, Acquisition and Storage of Information Concerning Nonaffiliated Persons and Organizations, 13 September 1974.
- e. Title 10, United States Code (U.S.C.), Section 892; and the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), Article 92, Failure to Obey Order or Regulation.
- 2. Applicability. This policy applies at all times and in all locations to all service members.
- 3. Off Limits Areas. In accordance with the recommendation of the AFDCB, the locations listed in Annex A to this policy are off-limits to military personnel. As a matter of policy, a change in ownership, management, or name of an off-limits establishment or area does not, in and of itself, revoke the off-limits restriction.
- 4. Punitive Provision. Paragraph 3 of this Policy Letter is punitive and intended to be a lawful general order within the meaning of Article 92, UCMJ, and 10 USC 892. Violations of paragraph 3 may result in punitive action under the UCMJ, adverse administrative action, or both.

Commanding General's Policy Letter #2 Annex A, Off-Limits Establishments and Areas List

As described in Commanding General's Policy Letter #2, the following areas are off-limits to military personnel:

- a. Xecutive Private Club, 836 South Fort Hood Street #32, Killeen, TX 76541
- b. Club Hypnotic, 1000 West Stan Schlueter Loop, Killeen, TX 76549
- c. All unlicensed tattoo parlors (Service Members should ask to see the Business Permit and most recent Health Inspection of the business).
- d. All places offering the following items for sale: Drug paraphernalia (to include spice), designer drugs, also known as bath salts, or any type of synthetic drug that can potentially cause dangerous effects.
