

ARMY AIRLIFT CLEARANCE AUTHORITY

- Airlift Offering and Challenge Cost Avoidance Reports.

ARMY OIL ANALYSIS PROGRAM (AOAP)

The AOAP's mission is to enhance combat readiness for war-fighters globally by extending the life of oil wetted components, detecting impending failures early before catastrophic failure occurs, and providing Life Cycle Management Commands the data required to make enhancements to weapon systems.

 Oil Analysis monitors the health of engines, transmissions, gear boxes, and hydraulic systems identifying mechanical issues before they become catastrophic.





- AOAP's "On Condition" oil analysis determines the quality of the oil and prevents unneeded oil changes resulting in significant savings in cost of oil disposal, new oil, and labor over the entire life of a system.
- AOAP Labs strategically stationed all over the world.
- Deployable Mobile labs provide flexibility and rapid response to warfighter needs.
