Fort Hood Medical Out-processing Instructions

These instructions apply to all Active Duty Service Members and their families during <u>Permanent Change of Station (PCS)</u> and <u>Transition Leave</u> before <u>Retirement</u> or <u>Separation from the military</u> (ETS)

Note: Much of what is contained here is also applicable to Active Duty Service members while on Leave or TDY away from Fort Hood.

Active Duty:

Your ID card is your "insurance card" and validates your eligibility for **emergency** medical care. It does not authorize you to receive routine or urgent care at government expense unless authorized by CRDAMC (Referral Management Office - 254-553-1846).

• If you are moving away from the local area, call <u>1-254-288-8888</u> to cancel any remaining CRDAMC appointments you still might have in in the system.

ETS Transition (Terminal) Leave

- You are still on Active Duty until midnight of your last active day. You are assigned to your previous unit and are subject to the same PCM pre-authorization rules that applied to you while you were at Fort Hood.
- Your separation orders will indicate if you are eligible for Transitional Assistance Management Program (TAMP) benefits, which include the ability to use TRICARE as your health plan for a specified amount of time.
 - Check your orders before you leave Fort Hood to see if you are eligible for TAMP
 - Visit <u>www.TRICARE.mil</u> to see what TRICARE programs (Prime or Standard) are in place at your new area or residence.
 - If Prime is available at your new residence, you will need to re-enroll once you arrive there but no sooner than 30 days before your last day on active duty. It will NOT automatically follow you.
- Army Reservists demobilizing at Fort Hood may be eligible for TRICARE Reserve Select (TRS). Visit <u>www.TRICARE.mil</u> for more information.

Retirement Transition (Terminal) Leave

- You are still on Active Duty until midnight of your last active day. You are assigned to your previous unit and are subject to the same PCM pre-authorization rules that applied to you while you were at Fort Hood.
 - Visit <u>www.TRICARE.mil</u> to see what TRICARE programs (Prime or Standard) are in place at your new area or residence.
 - If Prime is available at your new residence, you will need to re-enroll once you arrive there but no sooner than 30 days before your last day on active duty. It will NOT automatically follow you.

PCS leave

- You are still assigned to your previous unit until you sign in to your next duty station.
- Your Fort Hood PCM must still authorize all urgent care for you while you are traveling from Fort Hood and until your enrollment is changed at your next station.
- Please review TRICARE fact sheet "Moving made Easy" (click on hyperlink)
- When you in-process at your next duty station, ensure that your TRICARE enrollment is transferred from Fort Hood to the new station
 - Your ability to receive non-emergent care may be delayed if a Fort Hood PCM is still listed for you in DEERS.
- If you are admitted to a civilian facility, contact as soon as possible:
 - o The nearest DoD military treatment facility (MTF) (Army, Navy, Air Force)
 - Your previous unit (even if on transition leave, you are still on Active Duty)
 - o Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center (CRDAMC) (888-833-2607 / 254-553-1846).
 - If there is no MTF nearby, have the hospital call HUMANA at 1-800-444-5445 for medical care instructions.

Family Members & Retirees:

- Your ID card is your "insurance card" and validates eligibility for **emergency** medical care. It does not authorize you to receive routine or urgent care at government expense unless authorized by CRDAMC (or your new PCM at your next duty station).
- To enroll in TRICARE Prime, call 1-800-444-5445 or visit www.TRICARE.mil for instructions. Newborns must be registered in DEERS and TRICARE within 60 days of birth.
- If you are traveling out of the local Fort Hood area and need urgent care, call HUMANA Military at 1-800-444-5445 for medical care authorization. A military ID card validates eligibility for emergency care. Emergency care in a hospital that does not result in an admission does not require pre-authorization. You must have an authorization from CRDAMC for urgent care which is not received in an emergency room. Routine (elective) care will not be authorized while traveling away from Fort Hood.
- If you are moving away from the local area, call <u>1-254-288-8888</u> to cancel any remaining CRDAMC appointments you still might have in in the system for any family members.
