Mahone Gate Closure



- This is a TEMPORARY solution; new Visitor Control Center (VCC) planned for Sisisky Gate in FY17 timeframe!
- Weekend visitor traffic at the Sisisky VCC posed a traffic safety hazard for those entering via Sisisky Gate and for traffic on Hwy 36
- As the Sisisky VCC is limited two work terminals, visitor traffic in the queue constantly exceeded the capacity of the two lanes; causing backups
- To keep Mahone, Sisisky and Lee Gates open would require additional overtime for Security Guards who are currently working 500 hours overtime per pay period
- Closing the Mahone Gate and Sisisky VCC on weekends and opening the Lee Gate and Lee VCC given current manpower limitations was the optimal solution
- Augmenting the Security Guards with BMM Soldiers was not a favorable option

Lee Avenue: Mon-Fri, 0500-2000, Weekends and Federal Holidays: 0600-2300 Mahone Avenue: Mon-Fri, 0500-2300 Closed Weekends and Federal Holidays Sisisky Boulevard: Open 24 hours



Electrical Fires in Housing



Two Fires in RCI Housing

- Nov 28th 2021 Khe Sahn Ct
- Feb 13th 2029 Khe Sahn Ct

Cause of both fires were electrical in nature yet not identical

- 2021 crimped/exposed wire
- 2029 light fixture wiring

Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Army Installations, Housing and Partnerships approved a 100% inspection of quarters built during same period

- Inspections will be conducted 1 Oct 31 Dec 16
- F&ES Inspectors will accompany the RCI inspectors

Weather Events: Fort Lee experiences all seasonal events

Hurricane Season: "Current" 1 Jun - 30 Nov / Tornados / Lightning & Thunderstorms / Excessive Heat / Wind/ Winter Weather 1 Dec - 20 Mar

Inclement Weather Identification and Notification

- Weather event identified and tracked at the IOC
- Weather watches and warnings issued by IOC

Installation Decision Points (Duty and Non-Duty Hours)

- Weather scope, severity and impact to the Fort Lee comm
- Coordinated COA recommended by the "Crisis Action Team" to the Garrison Commander on delayed opening, early release, partial closure or full closure (MEF, Key and Essential Personnel previously identified)
- Review Fort Lee Policy No. 20-01 Operating and Release Procedures During **Adverse Weather Conditions**
- COA provided to GC/SC for final decision
- Situation Monitored until completion



Weather/Hurricane Update





Regional Impacts

- Wide spread power outages (on- and off-post)
- Communications disruption (cellular, land, internet)
- Road closures
- Flooding
- Downed trees and power lines (housing areas/children)
- Tornado activity
- Infrastructure / building damage
- Severe wind, rain, lightning, hail
- * Regional Hurricane issues are based upon past three years' weather events

- Hurricane Season in the <u>Atlantic</u> begins June 1st and ends November 30th.
- **Tropical Storm (TS)** A tropical cyclone with maximum sustained winds between 39 mph and 73 mph
- **Hurricane (H)** A tropical cyclone with sustained low-level winds of 74 miles per hour or greater.
- Major Hurricane (MH) A hurricane which reaches a sustained low-level wind of at least 111 mph at some point in its lifetime. This constitutes a category 3 or higher on the Saffir /Simpson scale.


- MWNS


Zika Update



 The Zika virus is primarily a mosquito-borne virus, but can also be transmitted sexually.

Symptoms include:

- > Fever
- Rash
- Joint pain
- Conjunctivitis (red eyes)
- Muscle pain
- Headache



- 4 out of 5 people infected do not have symptoms
- Mosquito that transmits virus requires
 8-10 days of standing water



- As of Jun 2016 at least 27 cases in Virginia; 5 cases in Central Region -


ALL CASES IMPORTED

Prince George County Schools Bus Information




- Routing process for school bus assignments are near completion
