

## Requirements for Motorcycle Entry:

Installation authorities will deny access to and/or ticket any motorcycle, moped, scooter operator not wearing the required PPE.

- All motorcycle, moped, and scooter operators must show proof of “Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF)” certified safety course completion.
- Valid driver’s license
- Current vehicle registration
- Proof of current insurance

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) will be worn at all times while operating or a passenger on a motorcycle, moped, or scooter on Fort Lee.

Required PPE is as follows:

- a. An U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) approved helmet properly fastened under the chin. A brightly colored helmet with reflective tape or decal is highly encouraged.
- b. Impact or shatter resistant goggles, wrap around glasses or a full-face shield attached to the helmet. Operators may not substitute a motorcycle’s windshield, fairing, or eyeglasses for proper eye protection.
- c. Full-fingered leather gloves, long trousers, long-sleeved shirt or jacket, and leather boots or over the ankle shoes.
- d. During daylight hours a brightly-colored upper garment will be worn. During hours of limited visibility and/or darkness, an upper garment with reflective material must be worn. If the operator is wearing a backpack, the backpack must have reflective material securely attached.
- e. Additional Safety Requirements:
  - (1) The use of headphones or earphones is prohibited while operating a motorcycle, moped, or scooter.
  - (2) Motorcycles, mopeds, and scooters must have two serviceable rear view mirrors, one mounted on each side.
  - (3) Motorcycles, mopeds, and scooters must be operated with their front headlight switched on high beam during daylight hours.
