88th RSC Mission: A geographically aligned and dispersed organization, building readiness by providing seamless, efficient and continual BASOPS services to primarily Army Reserve Soldiers, Civilians, Family members and units operating in our region. Provide Mission Command for assigned Bands and other units as directed.

Army Reserve Soldiers gain proficiency in technical skills by providing real-world support Operation Platinum Support:

- > More than 300 service members will conduct real-world hands-on training with the 88th RSC this year.
- > The goal is to allow Army Reserve Soldiers in low-density supply and maintenance specialties to perform and gain proficiency in their technical skills while acting in direct support to the numerous exercises and transient training events occurring on Fort McCoy.
- > By the completion of Operation Platinum Support, supply and maintenance Soldiers will have processed and inventoried thousands of pieces of equipment and are projected to complete more than 100 service and repair work orders.

88th RSC Fort McCov Draw Yard (FMCDY):

- > The Draw Yard is a set of common military equipment (mostly vehicles and generators), available at Fort McCoy for Exercise and Transient Training unit use.
- > The goal is to reduce transportation costs and RSOI time for Exercise and Transient Training units during their rotation.
- > The Draw Yard Equipment Set will be supported by contractors and Operation Platinum Support Soldiers and will be completely separate from ECS 67. The Draw Yard will support exercises in FY17 due to the long lead time needed for planning an Exercise or Transient Training Rotation.
