A. **SUBMIT Military Discharge Record(s).** Service document(s) must show release from service with an Honorable, General discharge reflected on DD Form 214 and/or Certificate of Discharge; a Veteran's Administration (VA) ID card is acceptable.

B. **REQUESTS:** You must call us to ensure we have receipt of your fax at: 609-562-4453/3147.

If your request is urgent (for example, upcoming surgery, a funeral, etc.) tell them the nature of the emergency and your deadline in the "Comments" section of [eVetRecs](#) or in the "Purpose" section of the [Standard Form \(SF\) 180, Request Pertaining to Military Records](#). Fax your request to our Customer Service Team at 314- 801-0764.

D. **What to expect:** Veterans - playing of TAPS and flag folding. Retirees - Full honors, playing of TAPS, flag folding and a weapons team (wpns team is contingent upon availability of military resources).

E. **Hours of Operation:** (Mon thru Fri) 8:00 am to 4:00 PM. Sunday: CLOSED. Weekends and Federal Holidays OPEN: 12:00 to 4:00PM Only. AFTER duty hours please leave a voicemail with name of Veteran, date of service and a return phone number; we will return your call the next business day.

F. **Obtaining a Burial Flag:** U.S. Post Offices are the primary issuing point for burial flags. Call and confirm with the post office in advance. Regional VA Offices can also help identify local issuing points.
